Stunt BOM appearance points: receive up to 20 points if you built the plane, up to 10 points if you finished an ARC, and zero points if the plane was an ARF or built or finished by others.

ENTRY FEE: \$20 for the first event, \$5 for each additional event; maximum of \$30 for the entire contest.
