

# **Danny's Tips**



I have decided to pass on a few tips and tricks that have been picked up over the years so shall publish them here over the next few months.

Please note, these are techniques that have worked well for me so try them at your own discretion although I hope that somebody finds something of use in these ideas.

## **Cleaning engines**

To remove baked on castor from engines and mufflers, CLR Oil and Grease Remover http://clrclean.com.au/products/oiland-grease-remover/ works great. Just ensure that you obtain the Oil and Grease Remover and not the regular CLR calcium, lime and rust variety.

After closing all the holes on an engine (venturi and exhaust) brush a little over the parts, leave for about 10 minutes and then just wash off the gunk with water. A toothbrush and wooden toothpicks help to clean between fins. Try it on a grungy muffler first to check your technique and time required. (It's also useful to clean oil stains from your garage floor)

Now that all the crapola is removed, if your engine is not shiny enough (maybe you are trying to sell the poor worn out thing) than this works quite well (I purchased some to clean up my\_tarnished tinnie fishing boat)

As with the CLR above, close all the holes, brush it on and flush off the residue with water.

It is advised to test cleaning chemicals on an inconspicuous part of the engine prior to use.

Now that your engine is clean and shiny we come to one of my favourite corrosion protectors, Inox MX3

https://www.inoxmx.com/products/mx3-lubricant/ It works just as well inside the engine and as I fly floatplanes it's very handy when an engine decides to go swimming. Made here in Oz it contains lanolin which is derived from sheep's wool and I have yet to see a rusty sheep. It's also useful in the workshop when drilling, tapping and machining aluminium.

One word of warning, After spraying Inox MX3 into an engine, do not flick the propeller to distribute the lubricant as the propellant may ignite and cause the engine to burst into life. It's safer just to turn it over slowly.

#### FROM MODEL ENGINES TO ENGINE TESTING EQUIPMENT by Peter Ellis

A note about one of Australia's early 1950s model engine manufacturers.

As most old, and not so old time modellers will remember, there was a shortage of model engines in Australia post WW2, and the few that were available were often expensive. Also, restrictions of the government of the day on overseas exchange, meant a further restriction on (luxury) model aero engines. A far cry from the enormous range available today.

Because of the shortage of engines in the early 1950s, some people in the wholesale side of the model business approached James Small & Co. to see if model engines could be built here. Enter the Comet 2.50 diesel, essentially a replica of the Elfin 2.49, except that the crankcase was gravity cast whereas the Elfin had a pressure die cast case. Probably between 500 and 1000 were made but, as far as I am aware, no count was kept and the engines were not serial numbered.

I was a one-time employee of the firm, and assembled and factory test ran the engines. Most were equal to the Elfin; a few were down on performance; and the occasional hot example would out-perform the average Elfin 2.49. As the crankcase was gravity cast, it required a certain amount of hand finishing, which is labour intensive. In those days they sold for about £7 to £10; i.e. the best part of a week's wages for most people. When we consider the cost of similar sized engines today, we realise that modern technology has certainly brought the unit cost down, along with an improvement in the quality. Today's modeller is well off. The firm of James Small & Co. was event-

ually sold. The principals opened up business again under the name of Fred Small & Son -Toolmakers. Their business is precision tools, and there is only one other firm in Australia that can match their standards. In their time they have contracted to NASA, and recently they have built machinery for making the piston camtech of the Camira engine. They are toolmakers to the automotive industry and other volume production machines, including testing gauges and such things as complete auto engine test equipment, in which the whole engine is placed within a testing rig and tested for everything. An Australian engineering firm: one of the best in the world; of which we should all be truly proud.

Editors note:- I used to work at the Fred Small and Son factory in Park Road, Cheltenham Vic. and whilst there I was never aware of this part of the company's history. Existing examples of these and a 1.5cc version are very rare and further historical information is very limited.

Hi Harry

On reading Robin's article on line rake in ACLN 260 (!!), I was reminded of an error in the plan of Paul Turner's "Road Runner" which can be downloaded off the web.

*This version shows the bellcrank mounted in the fuselage behind the tank. A long way back from the lead-out guides: bit of a worry.* 

In fact, the bellcrank should be mounted in the port wing, inboard of the tank, with the pivot being supported by the main spars plus upper and



lower plates. If anything, the lead-out guides should be slightly forward of the bellcrank pivot, to ease the line tension.

The pushrod then is bent in a dog leg, like a big Z-bend, entering the fuselage through a slot behind the tank, in front of the flap horn. The pushrod needs to be thick, at least 12 gauge, to provide adequate stiffness.

One should step back smartly on take-off to avoid the model coming in on the lines.

Robin is right about the stainless steel lines being too weak. A "Roadrunner" can easily come in at 32oz with 140cc metal tank, rather horrifying by today's standards.
