This AMA AA-sanctioned contest features four PAMPA classes of Precision Aerobatics, Old-Time Stunt, Classic/Nostalgia 30 Stunt, sportsman and expert classes of Profile Stunt; AMA Fast, High-Performance 1/2-A and 80-mph Combat; Profile, Class I, Class II, .15, Sport 40 and Nostalgia (profile and Class I/II) Navy Carrier; Northwest Sport, Northwest Super Sport, and Northwest Flying Clown Racing, Sportsman Flying Clown Racing and Dallas Goodyear Racing; Authentic, Sport, Profile, 1/2-A and Fun Scale; and 1/2-A Proto, .21 Sport, .21 Proto, Northwest B Proto and F2D Proto Speed.
