# SIRS MEETING MINUTES January 11. 2025

After an hour of in-door flying, President Randy Doss called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. at St Mary's School gym. There were 12 members present.

Larry read the minutes from the December 14, 2024 meeting. Dennis read the Treasurer's report. Both reports were approved as given.

#### **Old Business**

Randy presented the AED donated to the club by the Illinois Veteran's Assistance Program. The system will be installed at the field in the spring along with training in its use. CPR training for Club members and possibly others, will also be provided. More details to follow in the next couple of months.

The Z-mower recall will be coordinated by Larry.

The local chapter of the Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA) is developing a week-long summer program aimed at promoting an interest in aviation among kids ages 11-14. The EAA has requested the assistance of SIRS in building and providing a flying site for an Old School Model Works, aka Goldberg Falcon Fifty-Six, which will be the focal point of the program. SIRS is being asked to provide a few experienced balsa builders to teach up to 12 EAA "teachers" in constructing and setting up the first kit for flying, as there appears to be only one EAA member who has any experience with RC. The training will begin mid-February and run a couple of evenings a week until the kit is finished. The EAA teachers will assemble a second kit this summer with the kids. SIRS members who have currently volunteered to assist, if available, are Jerry, Al Kleinschmidt, Randy, Steve Loftus, Tom and Larry. Others having balsa experience are asked to step forward as well. This program is a work-in-progress so some flexibility is required. As an aside, the EAA distributes an impressive monthly color publication, and suggests that SIRS contribute articles and announcements from time-to-time.

#### **New Business**

Jerry suggested that more effort is needed to reach out to other local clubs to facilitate more interaction.

John Cralley stated that the Thursday 11:00 a.m. luncheons at Shannon's restaurant will resume. These were canceled due to covid. John will make the announcements.

The event to kick-off IMAC for the summer is scheduled for May 10-11 at our field.

Jerry promised a new and improved ballon burst this summer. Time TBD.

With no further business the meeting was adjourned.

The target audience is young people ages 11-14. The EAA is seeking the assistance of experienced SIRS builders to "teach the teachers" who will then conduct the workshop this summer.

The plan is to build an Old School Model Works fifty-six (aka:Goldberg Falcon 56) over the next few weeks in the EAA hangar at the airport. A second plane will be built with the kids during their summer workshop with the EAA instructors.

Members of the EAA who are involved in this program, hope to attend our next meeting at St. Mary's to explain the plan in more detail. It is hoped that 5 or 6 SIRS members will step forward and offer a few hours during the month of February to build the first plane with the EAA. Practically all materials needed to build an electric version of the planes have been provided by the EAA home office.

Please attend the next SIRS meeting to learn more about the program, which could be an important opportunity for SIRS to make an impact in the community! And assist another aviation organization who is seeking our help.
