
CLUB DOIN'S.....


A WOLF welcome to new member Don Dotter, of Turner. Don indicates on his application form that he is interested in aerobatics and racing activites. Welcome aboard!



FRONT-VIEW ENGINE TEMPLATES

To position the muffler, make a front-view template of your engine. After cutting a hole in a piece of cardboard for the exhaust pipe, put the engine and mount assembly onto the cardboard and trace around them, as shown. Before you cut out the template, mark the positions of the mounting holes, too.

TUBULAR PUSHROD CAPS

Bend the pushrod wire 90 degrees (a) and run it into the tubular pushrod (b) so that the short leg of the wire pops out through the hole (c). Smear epoxy over the dowel plug (d), then insert it into the pushrod. You can solder a washer (e) onto the wire, against the plug, but it isn't necessary. The short bend in the pushrod wire ensures that control-surface loads are mechanically transferred to the pushrod and don't have to rely on an epoxied joint.







Site will be open for camping and limited flying Thursday, May 25. No flying or camping on Wednesday.

RULES INFORMATION

- AMA events are per 2005-2006 rule book, except as noted below. Know the rules!
- Northwest Rules will be used for these events: NW Sport Race, NW Super Sport Race Flying Clown Race, .15 Carrier, Nostalgia Carrier, 80-mph combat, Vintage Diesel Combat, P-40 Stunt and Northwest Sport Jet Speed. Quickie Rat will use NCLRA rules. For complete rules, write John Thompson, 2456 Quince St., Eugene, OR 97405, JohnT4051@aol.com. Not knowing the rules is no excuse get a copy now!
- COMBAT 80mph and 1/2-A double-elimination; Diesel five rounds. 1/2-A combat will be flown on 42-foot lines, starters OK. FLYAWAY SHUTOFFS required in 80mph: Failure of a shutoff results in disqualification. from the event. Be sure that yours works!
- Precision Aerobatics Model Pilots Association rules will be used for Old-Time Stunt and Classic Stunt.
- · Safety thongs required in all events.
- Contestants may at some times be <u>required</u> to assist in timing or judging.

OTHER INFORMATION

- AMA or MAAC membership required for all participants. AMA membership available at registration.
- Only participants and officials allowed in flying areas. All others must stay outside roped-off or restricted areas.
- Absolutely no alcoholic beverages on flying field during meet hours.
- Awards Trophies through second or third place and merchandise through third place in each event and age grouping. Event champion trophies for each category!
- Product vendors contact Contest Director for permission and site info.
- Primitive camping allowed on site (no hookups). Commercial camping/RV locations nearby.
- Altendees must stay inside the fenced flying site and public areas. Entry to the adjacent airport land is restricted.
