- The results of the Ringmaster Fly-A-Thon was shared with the members by Dave Gardner who hosted the event. The event was held on Thursday, October 4th at North Green River Park in Kent, and Saturday, October 6th at the Algona-Pacific Elementary School on the corner of Milwaukee and Ellingson Avenues in Pacific.
