On the Contest Trail.....


Plenty of action in the Northwest contest scene the last few weeks.

The "big one" aka the Northwest Regionals took place in Roseburg on May 26 thru 28. The weather was outstanding this year, could not have asked for better conditions. COMBAT ENGINES:

Here are a couple of the popular combat engines that were seen at the recent Bladder Grabber contest.

On this page is a full size rendition of the Nelson 36 combat engine. This thing is a real fire-breather, but no need to tip the nitro can for performance with it. Most fliers typically use 15% nitro with it. And these engines are quite reliable and do last.

On the neighboring page is the Cyclon 049, which is shown full size from a drawing I made when the engine was relatively new. The Cyclon is now hard to get, but there is another one called the FORA, which is a near duplicate of it and also works quite well.




